(Memorandum of Executive Decision)

On the recommendation of the sailing committee of the Chester Yacht Club, the executive has decided to write a deed of gift to reflect the current use of this trophy. It should be noted that the deed of gift has been missing since at least the 1930's and has been raced for in its present format for the past ten years.

- 1) This trophy is to be raced for in the month of August by both the A and B classes. It will consist of at least three races and four races if there is to be a drop race.
- 2) In the event that the handicap fleet ceases to exist in the Chester area the sailing committee of the time will have the authority to use this trophy for another race or series at their discretion.
- 3) It is to continue to be a perpetual trophy and can not be won outright.
