

Royal Canadian Legion Trophy

(Deed of Gift)

Know all men by these presents that the Royal Canadian Legion, F. E. Butler Branch No. 44, does hereby donate to the Chester Yacht Club, Chester, Nova Scotia, a trophy to be designated as the Legion Trophy and presented annually according to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) It is to be awarded to the winner of the Canada Day Race held each year on July 1st under the handicap provisions of the Nova Scotia Sailing Association.
- 2) In the unlikely event that this competition ceases to be held, the sailing committee of the time has authority to reassign this trophy to a race of comparable nature.
- 3) It is to be a perpetual trophy and cannot be won outright.
- 4) Should this trophy not be raced for in any three consecutive years--or--should any of the above terms and conditions be materially violated, the donor may, at its discretion, repossess same immediately.
