Cavendish, Charles Stewart Wurts, Jr., John Wister Wurts and Elizabeth F.W.Spahr, hereby donate to the Chester Yacht Club, Chester, Nova Scotia, in memory of our mother the trophy designated as the Elizabeth Wister Wurts Cup, to be presented annually to the winner of the Mother's Day race, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The race shall be known as the Mother's Race, a free-for-all for sailing craft, and shall be held annually at Chester at such time and under such Rules as may be adopted from time to time by the Racing Committee of the Club.
2. The race shall be open to sailing craft of all classes.
3. The skipper of each boat shall be a married woman or widow but no such woman shall skipper any boat in the Mother's Race which she has skippered during the then current Racing Season.
4. No motive power other than sails shall be used.
5. The Donors reserve the right upon thirty days' notice to the Club to alter the terms and conditions of the gift should circumstances in their opinion so warrant.
